THE COACH



Sue Ziegler

When Sue Ziegler came to Cleveland State four years ago there was no women's swimming team. Ziegler organized the program and has improved the caliber of competition each year. A graduate of Slippery Rock, she competed in swimming for two years and then served as a student assistant coach for the swimming Rockets for two years. After graduation she taught and coached for a couple of years in Pennsylvania public schools before earning an MS from Penn State. Currently an instructor in CSU's Physical Education Department, Ziegler is also taking courses at Penn State and West Virginia U. towards her doctorate.

THE FACILITIES AND PROGRAM

The Cleveland State women's swimming team conducts its program in the Physical Education Center Natatorium. The facility consists of two pools: one 50-meter by 25-yard exhibition pool, and one 25-yard instructional pool immediately adjacent. Diving facilities include two 1-meter maxiflex boards, two 3-meter maxiflex boards, and a 5, 7 1/2, and 10-meter tower.

The women's swimming program includes three hours of training a day with weights, swimming and videotape stroke work. For those who qualify, post-season competition is available at the state, regional, and national levels.

1975-76 OUTLOOK

In only its fourth year of intercollegiate competition, the Cleveland State women's swimming team is still in its building stage. This year's team will be the strongest, but still lacks numbers; only nine swimmers are on this year's squad.

All is not bleak, however, Senior **Cathie Hackett**, last year's "Outstanding Swimmer" returns in the sprint freestyle events while junior **Robin Krumwiede** is back in both distance freestyle and butterfly, and sophomore **Kathy Clementz** is back in backstroke and I-M. Sophomore **Ruth Reber** returns in the breaststroke while newcomers, freshman **Debbie Dugan**, in the breaststroke and I-M, and sophomore transfer **Gail Thompson** in the distance freestyle and I-M give the team a little depth.

"We have a tough schedule, but with hard work and perseverance I expect several to qualify for the Nationals this year," commented coach Ziegler.

THE RETURNEES

Kathy Clementz, sophomore from Lakewood, is a strong all-around swimmer, but her specialty is backstroke. She qualified for the AIAW Nationals last year in the 100-yard backstroke and on the 400-yard medley relay team. Two years ago she placed 20th in the National Junior Olympics in the 200-yard backstroke. Her major is physical education . . . **Cathie Hackett**, senior from South Euclid (Brush), was recruited from an intermediate swimming class during her freshman year. Barely able to swim 25 yards then, she qualified for the AIAW Nationals in the 50-freestyle and 400-medley relay last year and was named CSU's "Most Outstanding Woman Swimmer". Captain of this year's team she will graduate with a major in physical education . . . **Robin Krumwiede**, junior from Avon (Avon Lake), is strong in butterfly and improving in freestyle. Qualified for the AIAW Nationals in butterfly on the 400-medley relay team last year. Majoring in physical education . . . **Ruth Reber**, sophomore from Lakewood, her specialty is breaststroke in which she qualified on the 400-medley relay team for last year's AIAW Nationals. Also will be used in freestyle this year. Her major is physical education.
