

# THE CSU NATATORIUM

"The greatest swimmers in the fastest pool at the greatest meet in history," is how the NCAA Swimming Guide described the 1977 NCAA Swimming Championships held at the Cleveland State University Natatorium.

Since the doors opened in 1973, the CSU Natatorium has been a very special pool. It has not only served as the home to the CSU Vikings but to the 1975, 1977, 1979 and the 1984 NCAA National Swimming Championships. The 1977 meet saw an NCAA record 16 records broken, a mark which still stands today. Because of the frequent national competition staged at the pool, all three major television networks (ABC, CBS and NBC) have originated telecasts from the famous CSU facility.

The 50-meter indoor pool has been the host site of numerous record-smashing performances, to such famous swimmers as John Naber and Matt Biondi, The 1976 United States Olympic Swimming and Diving Teams practiced at the CSU Natatorium as did the 1980 Olympic Diving squad and 1984 U.S. Olympic Swimming team.

A mind-boggling 933,000 gallons of water fill the exhibition pool which is 50 meters in length (with nine eight-foot competitive lanes), 25 yards wide (with 20 seven-foot competitive lanes), is equipped with underwater speakers and six underwater windows for coaching and teaching. In addition, an ultrasophisticated automatic timing system with touchpads for up to 10 lanes is utilized during meets.

Diving facilities include two one-meter maxiflex boards, two three-meter maxiflex boards and a diving tower with platforms at 5, 7-1/2 and 10 meters. Each of the platform levels is served by an intercom which can be operated from the coach's position on deck.

Tucked away out of sight of spectators beneath the south stands is a bonus for the competitive swimmer, a 25-yard instructional pool used for teaching instruction on a daily basis which serves as an ideal warm up and/or warm down pool during major competitions.



# **HEAD COACH JOHN COLLIS**



After an outstanding 1991-92 season in which eleven school records were broken. John Collis returns for his second year as head coach for the Cleveland State women's swimming team.

A former standout swimmer for Indiana University, Collis was a member of three Big Ten Conference Championship swim teams during his four-year career in Bloomington. The 1986 I.U. graduate was coached by the legendary Hooiser swim mentor Doc Councilman.

Collis' previous collegiate coaching experience includes serving as an assistant coach for the men's swim team the past three seasons, as well as coaching a prominent local club team which included district, state, and national champions, and Olympic Trial qualifiers along with former assistant CSU men's swim coach Glenn Mills, a 1980 Olympian and NCAA National Champion.

Collis, whose best events are the 200-yard and 500-yard freestyle, was a member of the 1984 Greek Olympic Team. An All-American at Gates Mills (OH) Hawken School, he spent his last year of high school at Mercersberg (PA) Academy, where he earned national championship honors.

A 29-year old Cleveland native, Collis earned a B.A. in Chemistry from I.U. and is currently working on his Ph.D. in Applied Physiology.

# ASSISTANT COACH RUSS KASL



Russ Kasl is in his first year as an assistant coach for the CSU women's swimming and diving team. Kasl, a 1990 graduate of Eastern Michigan University, swam for three years at EMU and served as a student assistant coach his final season. This past year, Kasl coached 11 swimmers from the Ridgewood YMCA to the YMCA Nationals. Kasl is currently pursuing his master's degree in Exercise Physiology at CSU. He is single and resides in Parma, Ohio.

# **DIVING COACH JEFF ARNOLD**



Diving Coach Jeff Arnold is now in his tenth year with the Cleveland State University swimming and diving program. He has been a part of the CSU staff since 1982 except for a year's absence in 1986. Arnold rejoined the program before the start of the 1987-88 campaign.

In his first season with the Vikings he produced CSU's first Eastern Intercollegiate champion and sent four divers to the NCAA Zone Diving Meet, the largest contingent in Cleveland State history. That's nothing unusual for

Arnold, who turned out a collegiate All-American, nine high school All-Americans and several nationals finalists in age group competition during 10 years of high school coaching and 16 years as the head coach of the University Diving Club, which is affiliated with University School.

An industrial arts teacher at Eastlake North High School, he is married, the father of three children and resides in Fairport Harbor.
